2. Did this course meet your expectations? If not, what was missing?

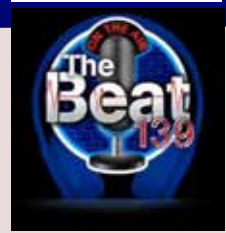
Absolutely.
